All entries should be clean, properly labeled and ready to hang, with a 4" hanging sleeve at the top.

All entries must have been completed in 2009.

Please provide one completed and signed entry form for each entry.

Please provide 3 (three) color photos (4"x6" or less) for each entry: full front view; full back view; and a close up of the details. Label the photos with your name, the quilt's title, it's size and the top indicated with an arrow. The photos will not be returned, but may be included in publicity for this event or inclusion in a compilation of quilt photos.

Entry fee of \$20.00 per item is required. Checks may be made payable to "Nia Quilter's Guild". No cash please.

Please provide a SASA business envelope for notification of the 1st place winner decision. Only one per person, not per quilt.

Information packet materials should be postmarked by October 9, 2009.

Information

Nia Quilt Guild (NQG) reserves the right to hang entries as space allows.

Entry fees will not be returned.

NQG reserves the right to reject any entry at show time, if we find the rules have not been followed.

Anyone may enter according to the rules.

Security will be provided before and during the show.

Please check with your insurance agent to make sure that your quilt is covered under your homeowners' policy while it is on display. Some companies require a temporary rider on the policy and others cover it while away from home for short periods of time. Any and all costs pertaining to this is the responsibility of the quilt owner.

All pieces must remain hung until end of event.

Pieces sold during this event will be assessed a 20% consignment fee.

Awards

1st and 2nd ribbons will be awarded according to attendee votes.

'Best of Show' ribbon will be awarded per Nia Quilt Guild members decision.
